WHAT: Happily Ever After League (H.E.A.L.) a nonprofit organization dedicated to nurturing, facilitating and providing support to mothers diagnosed with cancer. H.E.A.L. was founded in 2004 by mother and cancer survivor, Lauren Daniels. H.E.A.L. has helped more than 325 moms since its inception – an average of 70 moms each year.

WHO: H.E.A.L believes that any mother facing cancer treatment and recovery is deserving of support. To be considered for assistance from H.E.A.L, applicants must be a mother living in Arizona with at least one dependent child.

HOW: The efforts and support that H.E.A.L. provides are a direct result of the hard work of many dedicated individuals. Daniels, the H.E.A.L. board and support team have successfully partnered with volunteer organizations and major medical facilities for referrals.

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
